Builds upon the concepts of PHR-154. Provides understanding and knowledge base of pharmacologic therapies used to treat complex diseases. Teaches the unique knowledge base needed by pharmacy technicians. Arts & Sciences Elective Code: B Hours per week: 2.0 lecture

Prerequisite: Take PHR-154.

# PHR-165 Pharmacy Technician Calculations and Compounding With Lab (4)

Introduces calculations and conversions necessary to prepare doses and medication products. Teaches common sterile and non-sterile compounding techniques. Arts & Sciences Elective Code: B *Hours per week*: 3.0 lecture, 2.0 lab

Prerequisite: Take PHR-175.

#### PHR-173 Pharmacy Technician Clinical (1.5)

Provides the learner with opportunities for observation and supervised participation in hospital, retail pharmacy, and simulation settings. Arts & Sciences Elective Code: B
